WOW, it's hard to believe that the first half of the year is almost gone. We've already had some good matches and I promise they are just going to get better. Whether you just want to get away and have some fun with like-minded folks, or you're serious about honing your personal protection skills, the IDPA matches at TAC2 are where you need to be on the second Sat. of each month. The only way to get better and move up is to practice, practice, practice, shoot lots of matches and take as many training classes as possible.

As we promised last year, we've implemented some changes in the format of the matches. As a result, this year's matches are excellent. As a matter of fact, most matches are finished with 1<sup>st</sup> gun by 12:30-1:00 and that's with 6 good stages. We're usually done with second gun and side match by 4:00. As a reminder, some of the changes are as follows: Never limit the number of rds. you can shoot on steel; No weak hand only shots over 7 yds.; No strong hand only shots over 12 yds.; Fewer awkward shooting positions; More in your face, do or die situations; No surprise stages (too hard to keep it fair for everyone); More "real life" scenario based situations. If any of you have further suggestions, please call or e-mail me. After all, you are the ones that TAC2 is here for. I'm trying to keep it fun for everyone.

For those of you that are new to TAC2, we give awards to the Division winners each month. The winner in each Division will get a prize of some sort. You will get a Free Match card, which can be redeemed for a regular match or a TAC2 hat, or you can save them and redeem 2 cards for an embroidered TAC2 shirt. You are not eligible if you have won in the last 6 months. If the top shooter has already won once, then the next shooter will win. It will only go down to the 3<sup>rd</sup> shooter in that Division. 2<sup>nd</sup> gun will not count in this program.

RED indicates they had already won in the last 6 months and there were no other 1<sup>st</sup> Gun shooters in the top 3 in that Div. that had not won in the last 6 months. BLUE indicates that there were no 1<sup>st</sup> Gun shooters in that Div.

In addition to the previously mentioned changes/additions to our match schedule this year, we're also holding a long-gun side match most every month. We do this in conjunction with shooting second gun. You should be able to do both. The rifle or shotgun side match will be 2 to 3 stages. This will allow you to keep tuned up on shooting them and they will also be lots of fun. We started with a rifle side match in April and will alternate between rifle and shotgun each month. Check the web site for the most current information. Side matches will only be \$5-\$10, depending on how many stages we set up. Bring your long gun and have some fun. **July will be a shotgun side-match, with some transition to handgun.** 

Remember, "Cowboy Action Shooting" is now at TAC2. We are having CAS matches here on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of each month. This is a neat addition to our schedule. Come on out and participate, or at least watch. I'll bet someone will let you shoot their blasters. The Greene County Regulators are running the matches.

#### "ANNUAL GUN GIVEAWAY" - CONGRATULATIONS TO DAN THOMAS AND BOB McCLELLAND !!!

We had the drawings for our 1st ANNUAL GUN GIVEAWAY, at the June match. We'll be giving away 2 guns each June. One will be a drawing from all the shooters that make at least 6 monthly matches in the next year. All you have to do, to be in that drawing, is just come and shoot. No particular skill level required. You will have one ticket/chance in the drawing, for each match you shoot, provided you shoot at least 6 matches in the next year. (I.E. – If you shoot 5 matches, NO chance. If you shoot 6 matches, 6 chances. If you shoot 9 matches, 9 chances, etc.) The more you shoot, the better your chances. Second-gun will NOT count toward these drawings.

The other gun will be a point series drawing. The way it will work is this; **1** – You must shoot at least 6 matches in the next year. **2** – Only 1<sup>st</sup> gun will count. **3** – Your scores from the "Bill Drill" and the "IDPA El Presidente" will be averaged. **4** – The lowest average in each Class (including NV), in each Division, will go into the drawing. That's no more than 20 people max., in the drawing. Pretty good odds, ain't it!!! **5** – You will be ranked on which class the majority of your scores were shot in. (I.E. – If you shoot 5 matches as a Sharpshooter, then move up to Expert and shoot 4 matches; for purposes of this drawing, you would be a Sharpshooter. If you shoot an even number in each, then you will be considered in the lower Class. That doesn't sound nice, but you know what I mean.) I may have to tinker with this a little, but not in any significant way. I am disqualifying myself from these drawings. **PLEASE NOTE – YOU MUST HAVE A CLASSIFICATION ON FILE AT TAC2 TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS DRAWING.** You don't have to be an IDPA member, per se, but you must have an IDPA Classification on file at TAC2, or you **MUST** shoot the Classifier at TAC2. It will cost \$10 to shoot the Classifier and it will be available at every match.

#### GUN GIVEAWAY UPDATE

In addition to the two drawings described above, we're adding another way to get more chances in the pot. On the attendance drawing, you will also get an additional chance for each new shooter you bring to a match. This will be independent of your attendance. If you only make 3 matches, but bring a new shooter each time, then you will have 3 chances in the drawing.
